WHEREAS, I, Aneta Thompson, the said Aneta Thompson
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of
even date with these presents, I am well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of Five hundred and Fifty (\$550.00)
Dollars, to be paid 15th day of August A.D. 1929.

with interest thereon, from date 1921 at the rate of 8 per cent per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal, and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of \$75.00

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That Aneta Thompson the said Aneta Thompson

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me the said

Aneta Thompson
in hand well and truly paid by the said

Mrs. Mary McM. Bailey
at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bar-
gain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. Mary McM. Bailey, her heirs and assigns

forever: all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situated
lying and being in Cassie Mt. Township, Greenville County,
State aforesaid, about 7 1/2 miles from the city of Greenville
and having the following metes and bounds, be shown on
plat made by W. A. Dwyer, Sept. 16th 1924, to wit:
Beginning at a stump on the Northwest corner of this tract
on line of land belonging to Mrs. Minnie Hynn and on
line of land belonging to Warren Gibson, and running
thence along the Gibson line S. 11 3/4 W. 23.00 chs to a
red oak stump on the North side of the Hunt's Bridge Road
on the Northwest corner of a tract of land conveyed by
C. R. Thompson to H. M. Burns by deed dated Nov. 10th 1924
and recorded in the R. D. C. for Greenville County in Book Vol.
91 at page 599; thence along the said Hunt's Bridge Road
(separating this land from the Burns land) S. 60.00 E. 5.00
chs. to a stake at the junction of said Hunt's Bridge Road and
another road; thence up said road N. 2 1/4 W. 38.83 chs to a stake
at the junction of said road and a third road; thence up
said third road N. 6 1/2 E. 5.32 chs to a stone on a branch; thence
down said branch following the meanders thereof as a line ap-
proximately N. 66.00 W. 2.60 chs; to the confluence of said
branch with another branch; thence up said second branch
(separating this land from land belonging to Mrs. Minnie
Hynn) following the meanders of said branch as a line
approximately as follows N. 66.00 W. 2.60 chs to a bend in
said branch; thence N. 20 1/2 E. 4.85 chs to a bend in said
branch; thence N. 10 3/4 E. 4.09 chs to a bend in said
branch; thence N. 3 1/4 E. 4.50 chs to a bend in said branch;
thence N. 4.00 W. 3.35 chs to a stake; thence leaving the
branch and running N. 67 W. 4.68 chs to the beginning
containing 12 1/2 acres more or less, and being the same
land conveyed to me this day by C. R. Thompson.
