- §9.19. Wherever in this Indenture the Company is required to furnish to the Trustee any certificate or other document on or before a specified date, such certificate or document if later furnished may nevertheless be acted or relied upon by the Trustee with like effect as if furnished when so required; but this provision shall not be deemed to impair any right or remedy which the Trustee may have to enforce the obligation of the Company to furnish the same as and when so required.
- §9.20. In order to facilitate the recording or filing of this Indenture, the same may be simultaneously executed in several counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original, and such counterparts shall together constitute but one and the same instrument.
- §9.21. The following Schedule, referred to in Granting Clause First hereinbefore contained, shall constitute a part of the description of the properties and franchises hereby granted, bargained, sold, released, conveyed, assigned, transferred, mortgaged, pledged, set over, warranted and confirmed unto the Trustee with like effect as if set forth in full in said Granting Clause, namely:
