Fourth: All the buildings, plants works, structures, shops, nipes, improvements, streets, ways alleys, passages, sewer rights, water, water courses, easements, estates, rights franchises, interests, privileges, liberties, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever belonging or appertaining to the properties and assets hereinabove by Clauses First, Second and Third of these Granting Clauses granted and demised or intended to be granted or demised or to any of the properties or assets hereafter constituting part of the Trust Estate or which shall hereafter belong or be appertaining thereto or to any part thereof, however acquired and whether or not as renewals or replacements of, or in substitution or exchange for, any of the properties hereinbefore described; together with the earnings, revenues, rents, issues, profits and income thereof, and all the estate, right, title and interest, possession claim and demand of every nature and kind whatsoever of the Corporatin as well at law as in equity of, in and to the same, and every part and parcel thereof.

Fifth: Together with all the estate, right, title and interest of the Corporation in and to all equipment, trade fixtures, furniture, furnishings, appurtenances and other fixed assets (as hereinafter defined) of every kind and description now or hereafter attached to, used or produced for use in connection with the premises hereinabove described or hereafter acquired by the Corporation, or the buildings or improvements now erected or hereafter to be erected thereon, or on any additions thereto, and all additions hereafter made to said buildings or improvements; and all fixed assets (as hereinafter defined) of the Corporation at any time in said building or buildings now owned or which may be hereafter acquired by the corporation.

Sixth: All other fixed assets (as hereinafter defined) of every kind, real, personal or mixed, now owned or hereafter acquired by the Corporation.

The term "fixed assets", for all purposes of this Indenture, shall be taken to mean and include (a) all real estate and interest in real estate (including leaseholds), and (b) all buildings, machinery, fixtures, furniture, furnishings, equipment and also all articles of personal property as are generally classified as fixed assets by good accounting practice.

To Have and to hold all and singular the above granted premises and property, equipment, rights and interests, whether real, personal or mixed, whether now owned or held or hereafter acquired, unto the Trustee, its successor or successors in the trust and its and their assigns forever.

In Trust Nevertheless, for the equal and proportionate benefit and security of all present and future registered owners of the Certificates issued by the Trustee under this Indenture, and for the enforcement of the payment of the Bonds and the interest thereon in accordance with their terms and the performance of the compliance with the covenants and conditions of this Indenture, without preference, priority or distinction as to lien or
