It is agreed and covenanted by and between the said parties that if the said Mertgager does not held said premises by title in fee simple, or has not good right and lawful authority to sell, convey or encumber the same, or if said premises are not free and clear of all liens and encumbrances whatseever, or if any suits have been begun or shall be begun affecting the same, or if any tax or assessment be made or levied upon the debt secured hereby or upon the Mertgages, or its successors or assigns, for or on account of this leam, either by the State or County, or for any local purpose, the Mertgages, or its successors, shall have the right to declare the entire indebtedness secured hereby at once due and payable, and the Mertgager, or the person or persons claiming or helding under the Mertgager, shall at once pay the entire indebtedness secured thereby.
