WHEREAS, *I*, the said *J. G. R. Hooper, Attorney of Fact*
in and by *my* certain *Promissory* note in writing, of
even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to

Dollars, to be paid *One year after date*

with interest thereon, for *date* *Oct 29 1928* at the rate of *eight* per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid *annually*

until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
