SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS *we*, the said *George W. Mahon and Mary E. Mahon*
in and by *them* certain *promissory* note in writing, of
even date with these presents, *are* well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of *Six hundred fifty (\$650.00)*
Dollars, to be paid *one year from date,*

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid *semi-annually*

until paid in full. all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten percent*
besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any
part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note,
reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *William Goldsmith, agent* the follow

ing described property:
*all that space parcel, or lot of land, situate, lying
and being in the County of Greenville, State aforesaid, first
Dunklin Township, containing 1/3 acres, more or
less, on waters of Reedy River, bounded by lands
of J. J. Chumate, William Halland and Reedy River,
beginning at a asp 3x on Reedy River; thence
S. 78 N. 33.50 to a stake 3x; thence S. 174 N. 4 33 to a
stone 3x on a small branch; thence along said
branch N. 95 to a White Oak 3x on branch of Reedy
River; thence with said Reedy River to the be-
ginning point, and being the same land as
conveyed to G. W. Mahon by William Mahon
Oct. 16th, 1908, Deed Book 222, page 236 and
