party of the first part, and the MECHANICS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, of Greenville, S. C., a corporation, party of the second part,

WITNESSETH, Whereof, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Five Hundred and Fifty Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly,

the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure: 33  
Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, 33 a part of the subdivision known as McCallough Heights, and being designated as lot no 35 of said subdivision. And having, according to a plat thereof, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "E" at page 95, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of Verdun Street at a point 234 feet from the northeast corner of Franklin Road and Verdun Street; and running thence N. 45-26 E. 157.6 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 44-20 W. 60 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 45-26 W. 157.6 feet to an iron pin on Verdun Street; thence along the west side of Verdun Street S. 44-20 E. 60 feet to the beginning corner.

Being the same lot conveyed to me by Leila J. McKinney by deed dated January 7, 1927, and recorded in Vol 104, at page 372, in the Office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County.
