X Also, all that certain lot of land being known as Lot No. 5, Block "D", Carolina Court as shown on plat of said subdivision, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina and being more particularly described as follows:

X Beginning at a point on the Eastern side of Montevista Avenue, 263 - $\frac{3}{10}$ feet from the Eastern corner of Montevista Avenue and Laurens Road, and running thence S. 55-21 E. 188.8 feet, more or less to a stake on line of original survey of boundary; thence N. 20-52 E. 65 feet along line of original boundary survey; thence N. 55-16 W. 185.3 feet to the Eastern line of Montevista Avenue; thence along Montevista Avenue S. 23-55 W. 64.6 feet to the point of beginning, being the same lot of land conveyed to American Bank & Trust Company by E. Luman Master, by deed dated March 9, 1926 and recorded in Book 110 at page 246 in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.

X Also, all that piece parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid:

Beginning at a point on the Northwest side of a ten foot alley, which point is 148 feet West of River Street, and said line of said alley is "West Page"
