WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Two hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000.00) Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

Fagins~~ West half of Lot No. 12 of subdivision of the Quist property, and also as Oakwood, plat made by W. O. Meeks for Greenville, April 1, 1911, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a post now the north side of Quist Avenue 200 feet from the corner of Fetherfield Street (or Arkansas Landing Road) and Quist Avenue, and running thence N. 64° 30' E. 50 feet to an iron pin, being the corner of Lot No. 12 as stated above; thence N. 38° 15' E. 18 feet and 6 inches to an iron pin, the rear in a line parallel with Quist Avenue 60 feet to the corner of Lots 2 and 3 to an iron pin; thence 189 feet six inches to the beginning corner, being the same lot conveyed to B. B. Smith by C. B. Lewis, R. T. Thorne and P. O. Lewis by deed recorded Feb. 5, 1911, page 512, and conveyed to W. R. Hale by B. B. Smith by deed dated April 2, 1923 recorded in Vol. 82, page 29 in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County.
