per cent per annum, payable weekly,
the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

Just outside of the corporate ~~limits~~ ^{limits} of the city of Greenville, known as part of No. 47 lot of Suburbia Land Company, of which is known as Sans Souci Villa, said lot being recorded in office of R. M. B. for said County in Plat Book "A" pages 510-511, said lot having the following courses and distance Beginning at an iron pin on Brockman Avenue, corner of ~~lot~~ ^{No. 48}, and running thence with line of said ~~lot~~ ^{lot} 258 feet to another pin; thence S. 13° 30' W. 88 feet to a stake, corner of other property of L. J. McFinney; thence with her line in a North Westerly direction approximately 213 feet to a stake on Brockman Avenue; thence with Brockman Avenue N. 10° 30' E. 60 feet to the beginning corner.
