

All that certain lot, piece or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, near the Greenville Depot, beginning at a stake on Vardry Street, and running thence with said street S 74 E. 117 1/2 feet to stake; thence N. 72-2 E. 84 feet to a stake on a street 48 feet wide; thence along said street N. 20 3/4 St. 240 feet to a stake on a street 50 feet wide running S. 26 1/2 St. thence along said street S. 26 1/2 St. 253 feet to the beginning corner, containing two roads and eleven poles, more or less, including all buildings and improvements thereon, and bounded by Greene Avenue, Vardry Street and Markley Street, as shown on City map in the Auditor's Office at page 73, as the property of Allen Temple, A. M. E. Church and being the same lot conveyed to the Trustees of said Church, by the Trustees of the Washington Street Presbyterian Church by deed dated December 1880, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book LL at page 162; and the mortgagors hereby represent that they are personally liable for said debt and that the said church membership have authorized the execution of this mortgage; that A. C. Sumter is the Pastor and Ex-officio Chairman of the Board of Trustees, and that the other signers are the duly elected Board of Trustees.
