We, Henry Gaillard and Betty Fisher

of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, **we**, the said **Henry Gaillard and Betty Fisher**

in and by certain note or obligation, bearing date the **4th** day of **February** **1930**

incorporated under the laws of such State) in the sum of **Three Hundred (\$300.00)** Dollars,

with interest thereon at the rate of **eight** per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the **4th** day of **February** **1930** A. D. 192

according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that **we**

the said **Henry Gaillard and Betty Fisher,** shall pay or cause to be paid to the said

Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of **Feb. March**

1930, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of **Four & 75/100 (\$4.75)**

Dollars, (**\$3.00** Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the **three** Shares of Stock, and **One & 75/100 (\$1.75)**

Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of

Four & 40/100 (\$4.40) Dollars, (**\$3.00** Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and **one & 40/100 (\$1.40)** Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due);

for the next twenty months the sum of **Four & 05/100 (\$4.05)** Dollars, (**\$3.00** Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and **One & 05/100 (\$1.05)**

Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of **Three & 70/100**

Dollars, (**\$3.70** Dollars, (**\$3.00** Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and **70/100 (\$0.70)** Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay

the sum of **Three & 35/100 (\$3.35)** Dollars, (**\$3.00** Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and **35/100 (\$0.35)** Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said **three**

shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by **Henry Gaillard and Betty Fisher** to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made

and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against the said **Henry Gaillard and Betty Fisher**

in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That **we** the said **Henry Gaillard and Betty Fisher**

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company,

according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to **us**

the said **Henry Gaillard and Betty Fisher**

in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby

acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company,

all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

Lying on the southeast side of Parker Street In Ward One of the City of Greenville, having a frontage of thirty-six (36) feet on Parker Street and a depth of fifty-one (51) feet, and being the same lot conveyed to Henry Gaillard and Betty Fisher by J.
