computed and paid **annually**

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bar-

gain, sell and release unto the said **G.M. Henson**, **All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate,**
lying and being in the State and County aforesaid and having the following metes and bounds
to-wit: Beginning at a large black gum on the East side of an old road near the Elija -
Ballenger spring branch waters of South Tyger River and runs thence N. 29-1/2 W. 9.07 chs. to
a bend in an old road; thence N. 29 W. 7.69 chs. to a bend; thence N. 26-1/2 W. 7.65 chs.
to a bend; thence N. 37-1/2 W. 7.69 chs. to the Rector old line in the center of the Mostella
Road; thence N. 74-3/4 E. 32.06 chs. to a stake in south Tyger River; thence down the
meanderings of said river about 16.17 chs. to a stake, J.A. Burnett's corner; thence with
his line S. 10-1/4 E. 20.50 chs. to a stake on the North bank of the Elija Ballenger Spring
branch; thence up the meanderings of said Spring Branch about 30.36 chs. to the beginning
