in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents well and truly indebted to AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, a corporation, incorporated under the laws of the State of South Carolina, in the full and just sum of Seven Hundred & 00/100 Dollars,

M. C. office for Greenville County, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Mary Cleveland Dodge Bates by deed dated March 25, 1920, and recorded in vol 48, page 252, R. M.
