computed and paid satisfied on my attorney
at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be

paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said J. H. Booke,

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said J. B. Ricketts, Attorney

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said J. H. Booke

in hand well and truly paid by the said J. B. Ricketts, Attorney

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. B. Ricketts, Attorney, his

successors and assigns: All that certain piece parcel of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville in Greenville Township, on the southside of Madison Street in Ward Three (3) of the City of Greenville and described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Madison Street in Ward Three (3) of the City of Greenville and running thence along Madison Street S. 42° W. sixty-six (66) feet and eight (8) inches to an iron pin; thence in a southeasterly direction fifty-seven (57) feet and nine (9) inches to an iron pin; thence N. 41° E. sixty-seven (67) feet to a locust tree; thence N. 48° W. fifty-seven (57) feet and seven (7) inches to the beginning corner. Also: All that other certain piece parcel of land in the County and State aforesaid and in Ward Three (3) of the City of Greenville, lying immediately in the rear of the lot of land hereinbefore described and being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a stake in line of Hartwell, one hundred and fifty (150) feet south of Washington Street and running thence along Hartwell one in a southerly direction sixty-seven and one-half (67 1/2) feet to an iron pin; thence in a westerly direction parallel with Washington Street, sixty-five (75) feet to an iron pin; thence in a northerly direction along rear line of the above described lot, sixty-seven and one-half (67 1/2) feet to a new corner; thence in a westerly direction seventy-five (75) feet to the beginning corner. The above lots were conveyed to L. L. Landrum by Margaret J. Cooper by deed dated November 22nd, 1923 and recorded in Deed Book 88, page 545, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County; and conveyed to me, J. H. Booke, by deed of L. L. Landrum dated November 9, 1925, and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 106, page 238.
