at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. F. Gallivan, ~~all that certain piece, parcel~~

~~of lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, in the Faileth Ward of the City of Greenville, containing three fourths ( $\frac{3}{4}$ ) of an acre, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stake N.W., about the back side of East Mt. Bee Avenue, a rod running thence along said Avenue, N.W.  $\frac{1}{2}$  N., 2.20 chains to a stake 3pm; thence E.  $\frac{1}{2}$  N., 2.64 chains to a stake 3pm; thence S.  $\frac{1}{2}$  E., 2.20 chains to a stake 3pm, in a valley ten feet wide, thence W.  $\frac{1}{2}$  E., 2.64 chains to the beginning corner, it being the same lot of land conveyed by Alexander Mc Bee, Esq., of the last Will and Testament of Vardry Mc Bee dec'd to Jacob Storey, Gabriel Cole, John Turner, Spencer Lewis and Jefferson Young by Deed bearing date the 4th day of July A.D. 1871 and recorded in the Register of Deeds Land Office for said Greenville County, on the 29th day of September A.D. 1871, in Book D.O. at page 69. And the trustee executing this mortgage on the part and in the name of said Springfield Baptist Church, personally makes and warrants the following facts: that the grantee last above named, purchased said property for and on behalf of said church, thereafter to be organized, that said church was thereafter duly organized under and by virtue of an Act of the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina, approved the 27th day of February A.D. 1872 (see: 15 Rob. Stat., page 65); that said church being duly organized, paid the purchase price of said land to said Alexander Mc Bee, as aforesaid and that said grantee of said Mc Bee, Esq., as aforesaid, were duly elected and served as the first Board of trustees of said church and held said property as such and turned the same over to their successors in office, as the property of said Springfield Baptist Church and that the said church has ever since held, possessed and controlled said property as sole owner thereof; and that a resolution was duly adopted by the members of said church, in regular conference duly assembled on the 15th day of Oct. A.D. 1929 (a majority of the members voting) authorizing, empowering and directing its present trustees, E. D. Curran, chairman, L. M. Stadden, secy., G. F. Brooks, George W. Parker, S. M. Todd, William Young, Fletcher L. Tephner, Willie Louis and Sylvester Clinton, and a majority of them, to execute and deliver on behalf of said corporation, Springfield Baptist Church, this mortgage and the note hereby secured.~~
