all that tract or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

On the White Horse Road and Reedy River and now  
 containing in both tracts 38 acres, more or less, and  
 described in Deed Book S.S.S. Page 221, also Deed Book  
 48, Page 84. The acreage in the land described in the  
 two aforementioned Deeds being 58 acres, but we conveyed  
 20 acres to J. B. Wynn by deed recorded in Deed Book  
 138 Page 238.

This is the same land devised to us under the will of our mother  
 Clarissa Thompson, deceased, said will being on file in the Probate Judge's  
 Office for said County and State in apt. 166, Page 32. The other devisees  
 Ella Robertson, Julia Walker and Brooks Thompson having conveyed their interest  
 in said tract of land by deed of conveyance recorded in Deed Book 107, Page 162  
 and Deed Book 91, Page 136. Also, all that piece, parcel or lot of land  
 situate, lying and being in the county and State aforesaid and in Paris Mountain  
 Township and on Reedy River and containing 9 acres, more or less, and has the  
 following marks, bearing and distances to wit: Beginning on a stone 3xnm on  
 Reedy River; thence S. 44° E. 21 to a stone 3xnm; thence S. 77½ E. 5.62 to a stone 3xnm  
 (on Wm's line) thence N. 21½ E. 2.30 to a stone 3xnm; thence N. 69° E. 10.90 to a maple 3xnm.  
 (on Old Reedy River bed) thence to the beginning corner. This tract is known as Tract no. 8.  
 of the estate of Thomas Thompson, deceased, as shown by plat made by Jno. M. Burton  
 S.D.S. on Nov. 14, 1905, and adjoining lands of Henry Wynn and Tracts nos. 7, 9, and 10,  
 as shown by the above named plat. Also all that piece, parcel or tract of land situate  
 lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Paris Mountain Township and containing  
11.9 acres more or less, and has the following marks, bearings and distances to-wit:

 by W. A. Hester, April 8, 1907, adjoining lands of Henry Wynn, et al. These being the same tracts  
 of land conveyed to us by Brooks Thompson, Julia Walker, and Ella Robertson, heirs at law  
 of Jno. B. Thompson, deceased, January 27, 1923, by deed of conveyance recorded in the
