*On the north side of O'Neal Street in City View and being the rear portions of lots Nos. 20 and 21 as shown on plat recorded in Plat Book A, page 461, and having the following metes and bounds. Beginning at a point on O'Neal Street, 100 feet from the corner of O'Neal and Y. M. C. A. Streets and running thence in a line parallel with Y. M. C. A. Street in a northerly direction 100 feet, thence with line parallel with O'Neal Street in a westerly direction 50 feet; thence in a line parallel with Y. M. C. A. Street and in a southerly direction 100 feet to O'Neal Street; thence with O'Neal Street in an easterly direction 50 feet to the beginning corner.*
