Charles, Attorneyin the full and just sum of Fifteen Thousand \$15,000Dollars, in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date here with, due and payable on the 10th day ofJanuary19301930Paid in full Julia1930with interest from date at the rate of 10% per month per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid semi annually, and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I have further promised and agreed to pay per cent. of the whole amount due for attorney's fee, if said note be collected by attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said S. J. Martinmt.in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Julia D. Charles, Attorneyall that tract or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

An execution known as Sans Souci, on the north side of Arlington Avenue, described as follows:

Beginning at a stake on said avenue 124 feet west of intersection of Pine St and Arlington Avenue corner of lot sold to Sybil Sullivan, thence with her line in a northeasterly direction 150 feet, thence parallel with Arlington Avenue in a westerly direction 54 feet, thence in a southerly direction 150 feet to stake on Arlington Avenue, thence with said avenue easterly 58 feet to the beginning.

For value received I hereby release the within described lot fronting 58 feet on Arlington Ave, and running back to a depth of 150 feet from the line of a mortgage given by S. J. Martin to B. E. Gee and recorded in the office of Register of Deeds Conveyance for Greenville County, Volume 1163, page 204. Dated at Greenville A. C. the 12th day of November 1929.
