SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *I*, the said *Ida Ledbetter*, in and by *my promissory note*, in writing, of even date with these presents, *am* *John E. Johnston*, well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of *Five Hundred and ~~50~~ 00 (\$500.00)* Dollars, to be paid *one year from date*.

with interest thereon, from *date* *1929* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum to be computed and paid *semi-annual* *July 1st*

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *10* *2* *5* *0* *0*.

*One hundred and ~~50~~ 00 (\$100.) dollars* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

gain, sell and release unto the said *John E. Johnston*, his heirs and assigns

forever, The following described property:  
All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known and designated Tax lot #8350 on plat recorded in office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Plat Book "A" at page 278 and 279, said lot fronts 66 feet on Chandler Street and runs back in depth 150 feet in parallel lines. This is the same lot of land, conveyed to me by Lillie Campbell by deed dated August 2nd 1927.
