SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *R. L. Keesler*, the said *R. L. Keesler*,

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal  
or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *Att. Oct. 20th 1926*  
*for the collection of*  
added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage), as in and by the said note, reference being

gain, sell and release unto the said *R. L. Keesler*,

All that piece of land situated in said  
state and county, back Spring ownership, near the  
town of Taylors, on the south side of the National  
Highway and the south side of the road  
and Northern Railway, adjoining lands of the Southern  
Railway and others, having the following metes  
and bounds, to wit;

Beginning at the stake and the edge of the said  
National Highway, running thence N.W. 28° W. 100 ft. to  
a stake on the edge of the right of way of the said  
Highway and Northern Railway, the said edge of the  
said right of way 330 feet to a stake on the edge  
of the said right of way, thence S. 28° E. 55.22 feet to a  
stake on the edge of the said National Highway,  
thence along the said National Highway about
