MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, Mrs. Othella Hughes Thornton,

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said Mrs. Othella Hughes Thornton
in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

P. L. Barr
in the full and just sum of Eight Hundred and Sixty (\$860.00)
Dollars, to be paid One year from date

with interest thereon, from November 11, 1929 at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal
or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Ten per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
thereto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the said Mrs. Othella Hughes Thornton

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

P. L. Barr, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

Mrs. Othella Hughes Thornton

in hand, well and truly paid by the said

P. L. Barr, and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released and by these presents do grant, bar-

gain, sell and release unto the said P. L. Barr, his heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land
situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina,
Greenville County, on the Parker Road, and being design-
ated as Tract no 55 on Plat no 2 of the property of the
Parker Land Company and containing 15 acres, more or
less, and being the same land conveyed to me by
A. B. Hughes by Deed dated January 5, 1929, and recorded
in the R. M.C. Office of the County and State aforesaid
in Deed Book 108 at page 425, the said property being
more particularly described in metes and bounds as
follows:

Beginning in the center of the Parker Road, in
the A. B. Tindall line, the southwest corner of Tract
no 64, run thence with Tindall line S 64 1/2 E.
21 chains and 50 links to the center of the Poor
House Branch, the southwest corner of Tract no
53, thence up the center of the Poor House Branch
and with the line of Tract 53 N. 7 1/2 E. 7 chains
and 63 links to a point in the center of said
branch, the southwest corner of Tract no 54, thence
with the line of Tract no 54 N. 64 1/2 E. 18 chains
and 90 links to the center of Parker Road in line
of Tract no 64 and the southwest corner of Tract
54, thence with center of said Road, and the line
of Tract 64 S 28 E. 7 chains and 32 links to the
beginning corner. This is the same tract of land
conveyed by A. B. Hughes to Othella A. Hughes
now Mrs. Othella Hughes Thornton.
