until paid in full all interest not paid when due and unpaid then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time due and unpaid then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of \$100.00, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which are secured under this mortgage) as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto, and as will more fully appear
