WHEREAS, I, W. A. Bates, the said, in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of

in the full and just sum of Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Ten percent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said, Bessie Norris Tilman

All that lot of land situate in the State and county aforesaid, just beyond the city limits of the City of Greenville on the Rutherford Road and designated as parts of lots nos. 3 and 4 of Woodside Circle, as shown by plat recorded in Plat Book C. Page 219, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County and having the following lines and bounds to-wit: Beginning at a point in the center of a brick wall on Rutherford Road, 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet S. of the joint corner of Lots 5 and 6, and running thence with the center of said brick wall, S. 66-0 E. 150 feet to a point in the rear line of Lot no 4; thence in a southerly direction with rear lines of lots nos. 4 and 3, 21 feet to point in the center of another brick wall; thence with the center of the last mentioned brick wall, N. 66-0 W. 150 feet to a point on Rutherford Road in the rear of lot no. 3; thence in a northerly direction with Rutherford Road 21 feet to the beginning corner.

This mortgage is intended to cover the lot with a brick store building thereon occupied by Bert Beaman which building is the third brick store building from the corner of Lots nos 5 and 6, and the lot described herein includes parts of lots nos 3 and 4 of the above mentioned subdivision.

This is part of the property conveyed to me by J. Centre and B. S. Chedress by deed dated December 17, 1920 and recorded in Deed Book 48 Page 566 R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.

This mortgage constitutes a first lien on said lot.
