SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said Margaret M. Patton, in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

*R. B. Davis*

in the full and just sum of forty-two hundred and no/100 (\$4200.00) Dollars, to be paid in twelve installments of \$350.00 per month, including interest, payable on 1st day of each succeeding month hereafter until paid in full, and the failure to pay any installment promptly when due shall make the remaining installments immediately due and payable, with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *per cent.* per annum to be computed and paid monthly

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *100/-* *33*.

... besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be paid as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, *20th Dec 1921* *35-03*, the said *Margaret M. Patton*, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *R. B. Davis*,

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said

*Margaret M. Patton*

in hand well and truly paid by the said *R. B. Davis*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *R. B. Davis*, his heirs and assigns forever,

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and in Greenville Township, just outside the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, being a portion of Lot No. 63, of the property of Overbrook Land Company, according to a plat thereof recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds as follows: in Plat Book No. 1, pages 251-2, and having, according to a plat of the property of Margaret M. Patton, prepared by Dallas & Meek (expidure), December 1921, the following metes, bounds, courses and distances to wit:

Beginning at a point on the south side of Overbrook Road, which point is 107.7 feet, in a westerly direction from the southwest corner of the intersection of Overbrook Road and Overbrook Circle, thence west 13° 45' 23.5 feet to a point, thence N. 76° 47' 88 feet to a point, thence W. 9° 15' 47.3 feet to a point on the Overbrook Road, thence along the south side of Overbrook Road, N. 84° 52' 53.5 feet to a point on Overbrook Road, thence continuing along said road N. 84° 52' 53 feet to the point of beginning."

This mortgage is junior and second to that one executed by me, covering the above described lot of lands, of the South Carolina Security Company, and is a purchase-money mortgage.
