WHEREAS, I, the said Ernest Capell, in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am

well and truly indebted to J. B. Hall, in the full and just sum of Four Hundred & Forty Dollars, to be paid One year after date of

with interest thereon, from date, at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid annually

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Ten percent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, on said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Ernest Capell, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said J. B. Hall,

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to the said Ernest Capell,

in hand well and truly paid by the said J. B. Hall,

at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. B. Hall:

All that certain pieces parcel or lot of land situated, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, in Ward One of the City of Greenville on the south side of Croft Street and described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the south side of Croft Street, 50 feet east of the south-east corner of Croft and Towles Street, as Towles Street is now laid out, and running thence in a southernly direction, in line parallel with Towles Street 106 feet to a pin; thence in an easterly direction in a line parallel with Croft Street 150 feet to pin; thence in a northerly direction, in a line parallel with Towles Street 106 feet to a point on the south side of Croft Street; thence with Croft Street in a westerly direction, 50 feet to the beginning corner found, being one of the lots formerly owned by Stone Land Company, plat of which is recorded in Plat Books 'A' page 337-345.
