WHEREAS, we, the said E. R. Hartsell and St. K. Townes, in and by our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, are well and truly indebted to,

Jean M. Davis, in the full and just sum of Seven Hundred Seventy-five (\$747.50) Dollars, to be paid one year after date.

with interest thereon, from date, at the rate of per cent. per annum to be computed and paid semi-annually, until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10 per cent. of amount due,

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage), as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Jean M. Davis, her heirs and assigns,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, and designated as Lot No. 1 of the Anna Scott Dawson property conveyed to us, said E. R. Hartsell and St. K. Townes, by E. Dunn, master, save and except a portion of said lot known as lot No. six (6) in a re-subdivision of the same by a survey made by W. M. Past. Said land is further described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of Scott Alley and the Old Paris Mountain Road, on the East side of Old Paris Mountain Road, and running thence with the Old Paris Mountain Road, S. 18-15 E. 322 feet to Profitt's line; thence with Profitt's line S. 7-30 W. 361 feet; thence N. 48-50 W. 203 feet to Scott Alley; thence with Scott Alley S. 73-36 W. 357 feet to the beginning corner.
