All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being at the southeast corner of the intersection of West Fair Road and Argonne Drive near the city of Greenville in the County of Greenville State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lots No. 18, 19 and 20 on plot of C. B. Martin subdivision recorded in the P. M. L. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book F at page 103 and having, according to a recent survey made by Dalton & Neves, September 29, 1939, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pipe at the southeast corner of the intersection of West Fair Road and Argonne Drive and running thence with the east side of Argonne Drive S. 41° 10' E. 236.8 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 17, N. 48° 50' E. 176 feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 41° 10' 24.83.8 feet to an iron pipe on the southwest side of a 20 foot alley; thence with said alley N. 71° 35' 24.130.4 feet to an iron pipe on the south side of West Fair Road; thence with the south side of said West Fair Road S. 69° 50' st. 116.5 feet to the beginning corner.
