C. Dalton, Engineer, March, 1923, recorded in the R. M. L. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book 3, at page 114 and 115 and having, according to said plat, and a recent survey made by A. Newton Stall, September 10, 1941, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin at the northwest corner of the intersection of Byrd Boulevard and Park Drive, said pin being the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 131 and 132, and running thence with the west side of Park Drive, S. 18° 35' 21.83 feet to an iron pin, thence continuing with Park Drive, S. 31° 00' 31.94.4 feet to an iron pin on said Park Drive, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 130 and 131, thence with the line of Lot No. 130, N. 41° 24' 21.178 feet to an iron pin, thence with the line of Lot No. 132, N. 82° 20' E. 194.8 feet to the beginning corner.
