whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said The

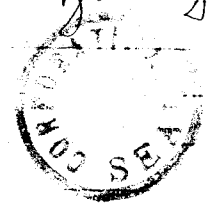
Prudential Insurance Company of America the following described real estate, to-wit:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements situate thereon lying and being on the south side of Croft Street in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as the eastern one-half of Lot # 33, Section 6, on plat of Stone Land Company recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "A" page 341, and having according to a recent survey thereof made by Dalton & Neves, August, 1935, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Croft Street, which iron pin is 217.5 feet west of the south-west corner of the intersection of Croft and Milton Streets and running thence S. 1-41 N. 200 feet to an iron pin on the north side of a 16-foot alley; thence along the north side of said alley N. 83-13 W. 54.37 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 1-41 E. 200 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Croft Street; thence with the South side of said Street S. 83-13 E. 54.37 feet to the beginning corner.
