SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I the said Annie C. Justice
in and by my certain Note or obligation bearing even date herewith, stand indebted unto THE PRUDENTIAL INSURANCE COMPANY OF AMERICA (a corporation duly chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and duly licensed to do business within the State of South Carolina, by the laws of said State) in the full and just principal sum of Thirty nine Hundred & no/100 Dollars (\$3900.00), with interest thereon from the date hereof, at the rate of set forth in the note aforesaid per cent. per annum, said principal sum being payable in instalments of Nineteen & 50/100 (\$19.50) Dollars each on the first day of each and every month hereafter, the last instalment (being the balance of principal remaining due) being payable on the first day of December

1948, and said interest being payable monthly on the same days as the instalments of principal, as reference being had to said Note will more fully appear; default in the payment of any instalment of principal or interest to render the whole debt due at the option of the Mortgagee.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, that I the said Annie C. Justice in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Prudential Insurance Company of America, a corporation as aforesaid, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of THREE DOLLARS, to me the said Annie C. Said note provides that past due principal and interest shall bear interest at the rate of five (5%) per cent. per annum.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the East side of Mc Donald Street, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 88 on plat of North Hills made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, April, 1925, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book H, at page 138, and having, according to said plat and a recent survey made by R. E. Dalton, April 14, 1942, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the East side of Mc Donald Street, at joint front corner of Lots No. 88 and 89, said pin also being 270 feet North from the northeast corner of the intersection of Mc Donald Street and Gallivan Avenue, and running thence with the East side of Mc Donald Street, N. 19° 17' E. 70 feet to an iron pin at joint front corner of Lots No. 87 and 88, thence with the line of Lot No. 87, S. 71° 43' E. 211.2 feet to an iron pin on the West side of a 20 foot alley, thence with the West side of said alley, S. 18° 34' 24. 75 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 89, N. 71° 43' 24. 212 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Mc Donald Street, the beginning corner.
