For value Received we hereby release the following described  
property from the lien of our mortgage in the sum of

1927, and recorded in mortgage Book 178, at page 21,  
Greenville County, South Carolina.

All that certain lot or tract of land, situate in Grove  
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, be-  
ginning at a stone in the center of the road leading to Green-  
ville, South Carolina, corner for Plumer Cothran: thence North  
33 degrees West 4.56 chains to another stone; thence South 45 $\frac{1}{2}$   
degrees West 3.53 chains to another stone: thence South 22 $\frac{1}{2}$   
degrees East 6.58 chains to a Red Oak in the center of the Green-  
ville road: thence as the center of said road North 47 $\frac{1}{2}$   
degrees East 4.61 chains to the point of beginning, and con-  
taining two and eighteen one - hundredths (2.18) acres,  
to be the same. more or less.

All that other certain lot or parcel of land, situate in  
Grove Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,  
beginning at a stake in the center of a public road and  
being the corner for the Tarrant land: thence as the line  
of the Tarrant land North 59 $\frac{3}{4}$  degrees East 3.35 chains  
to a point in the center of the Southern Railroad right of  
way: thence as the center of said Railroad right of  
way South 32 $\frac{1}{2}$  degrees East 30.34 chains to another point  
in the center of said Railroad right - of - way: thence South  
89 $\frac{3}{4}$  degrees East 5.37 chains to a stake in the center of  
the public road: thence as the center of said public  
road in a Northeasterly direction 31.48 chains to the point  
of beginning, and containing sixteen and four -  
fifths (16 $\frac{4}{5}$ ) acres, to be the same more or less.

It is expressly understood and agreed that this  
deed of release shall not in any manner affect  
the lien of our mortgage on the remaining lands  
therein described, but shall only operate to release  
the two tracts of land heretofore described from the  
lien thereof.
