J. Ross, his heirs and assigns One Thousand Dollars, (\$1,000.00) of the notes and mortgages held by me, given by Warren Walker, specified as follows, as shown by mortgages recorded in the P. M. O. Office for Greenville County, as follows:  
mortgage recorded in mortgage Book 223, page 267;  
Mortgage recorded in mortgage Book 139, page 282;  
mortgage recorded in mortgage Book 223, page 118;  
mortgage recorded in mortgage Book 77, Page 59,  
interest in the same to the extent of One Thousand (\$1,000.) Dollars, with interest from this date. Collection not to be enforced against said Warren Walker, my brother, until after my death, as it is my desire that he be not presently disturbed. Then, upon my death, the Collections can be made; this this instrument vests at this time One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars in the said C. J. Ross in said papers, and is a lien against said notes and mortgages to the extent of said \$1,000.00. This is intended as and is a present, deed of gift.
