NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Georgia Anna Harris

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Corinne Bates

all that tract or lot of land in the Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

Containing eight acres, more or less, situated and being on the south side of the white horse road, adjoining lands of Mrs. Ellen M. White, Telford Walker and others, and having the following courses and distance to-wit: Beginning at a stone 3x11 in, said road and running thence S. 44 1/2 E. 27.40 to a stone 3x11, Mrs. Ellen M. White's line on the south side of the road; thence S. 88 1/2 E. 5.92 to a stone 3x11 thence N. 44 1/2 E. 18.30 to a stone 3x11 in White Horse Road; thence along the road 4.00 to the beginning. The same being Lot No. 3 of the division of a tract of 114 acres, once a part of the Willis Benson estate. Also Lot No. 4, containing 7 acres more or less, adjoining lands of Mrs. K. Earle, Telford Walker and others: Beginning at a stone 3x10 in on the white horse road and running thence S. 29 1/2 W. 17.50 to stone 3x10 m, thence S. 60 1/2 E. 4.00 to a stone 3x11 thence N. 29 1/2 E. 17.00 to a stone in said road, thence along the road 4.00 to the beginning.
