

above mentioned at the E. C. Lynn corner and run South twenty-six degrees eighteen (18) minutes West 5.88 chains to an iron post; thence South fifty-five degrees N. 8.68 chains to a stone; thence North fifty-six degrees 15 minutes West 8.90 chains to an iron post; thence North thirteen degrees thirty minutes West 14.91 chains to said road; thence do over the road South sixty-five degrees thirty minutes East 22.50 chains to the point of beginning.

Provided, however, that the security of the Federal Land Bank of Columbia, as described in the mortgage hereinbefore first referred to and the security of Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation, as described in the second mortgage hereinabove mentioned shall, in all respects, except as to the premises hereinbefore described, be preserved and protected and that the liens of said mortgages, except as hereby released and discharged, shall remain in full force and effect and the terms, conditions and covenants thereof and of the respective notes thereby secured shall remain uncharged.
