in the full and just sum of One Thousand One Hundred Fifty & 00/100 (\$1,150.00)
to be paid two (2) years after date

with interest thereon from the date of this mortgage
at the rate of 7% per annum, to be computed and paid
semi-annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

Woman's College Successors and Assigns:
All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements situate thereon, lying just outside of the city of Greenville in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the east side of Labron Street, known and designated as Lot 11.6 of Block "B", subject of O.P. Miller property as shown by plat recorded in the N.M.C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book "C", page 284, and having according to said plat the following lines and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:
Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of Labron Street, which iron pin is at the joint corner of Lots 5 and 6 on said plat, and running thence along the joint line of said Lots 175 feet, more or less, to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lots 5 and 6; thence S. 36-14 E. 40.8 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots 6 and 7; thence along the joint line of said Lots, S. 61-08 W. 168 feet to an iron pin on the east side of Labron Street; thence along Labron Street N. 35-32 W. 56.3 feet to the beginning corner, being the same lot conveyed to the Mortgagor herein by deed dated March 14th, 1922, and recorded in the N.M.C. office for Greenville County in Book Volume 78, Page 133.
