according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration to the further sum of Three Dollars, to me

in hand well and truly paid by the said J. Gentry Edwards at and before signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-

edged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by the Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. Gentry Edwards his heirs and assigns all that piece, parcel and tract of land, situate, lying and being in Highland Township, County and State aforesaid, containing 7.40 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Commencing at a iron pin in the center of Rutherfordton Road, joint corner of Lots nos 2, and 3, and running thence along the center of said road S. 16° 24' 8.50" to an iron pin in center of said road; thence S. 61° E. along line of Lot no 3, 10.70 to a pin in joint line of Hilton Babbs land and the Stokes land, thence N. 27° E. 4.70 to a pin in said joint line; thence N. 45° W. 13.00 to the beginning corner, being known and designated as lot no 3 of the lands of J. Stokes, as subdivided and platted by W. P. Morrow, October 26, 1933 said plat to be recorded and reference is hereby made to the same for a more complete description.

Distances given above refer to chains, as shown by the plat referred to. Reservation is made herein of the Stokes graveyard, approximately 25 by 30 feet, as fenced near the road, with the right of ingress and egress. The above described property is the same conveyed to me by J. S. Stokes and J. S. Moon, Executors, by deed dated January 3rd, 1934, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deeds Volume 111 at page 437.

Also all that certain tract, parcel or lot of land lying and being in Highland Township, and Greenville County, and in the State of South Carolina, and being a part of lot no 1 of the subdivision of the Estate of J. S. Stokes, having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances: Beginning on an iron pin in the center of the Rutherfordton Road; thence S. 45° E. 4.00 to a stake on the line between lot nos 1 and 2; thence N. 17° E. 2.70 to an iron pin; thence N. 45° W. 3.90 to a point in the said road; thence down the said road, S. 24° W. 2.58 to the beginning corner, containing one acre more or less and joined by lot nos 1 and 2, and by Hilton Babbs and others. Being the same lot of land conveyed to me by deed of Lester Stokes, dated January 25th, 1934, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deeds Volume 175 at page 228.
