 All those three certain lots of land in the County and State  
 aforesaid near the City of Greenville (on Augusta Road and  
 Augusta Place) and having in the aggregate the following  
 metes and bounds, courses, and distances: Beginning at a  
 point on Augusta Road, corner of lot formerly occupied by  
 me to A. H. Cochran, Jr., and Mary Cochran, and running along  
 Augusta Road, S. 53° 21' E. 75.1 feet to a stake on corner of lot  
 #1; thence with said road, S. 46° 55' E. 87.6 feet to stake; thence  
 N. 58° 45' E. 237 feet to stake on lot of Simpson; thence along said  
 lot, N. 31° 30' W. about 246 feet to stake on "Augusta Place Street,"
