All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate

ship, being six acres of land, as per plan of survey, State approved, shown as
lot No 7 on a plat made by W. G. Clegg and never recorded
dated Nov. 1928 and more particularly described as follows
to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on Aberdeen Avenue
corner of lot No 7 and running thence with joint lines
of lots 6 and 7 N. 65-04 W. 173.5 feet to an iron pin; thence
N. 24-35 E. 60 feet to an iron pin corner of lot No 5; thence
S. 64-24 E. 171.8 feet along joint line of lots 5 and 6 to an
iron pin on Aberdeen Avenue, thence S. 22-54 W. 64 feet to the
beginning corner, this being the same lot of land conveyed
