of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:
Nellie McMillon, of Greenville

WHEREAS, the said Nellie McMillon in and by certain note or obligation, bearing date the 4th day of July 1932

indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Eight Hundred (\$800.00) Dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly from the 14th day of July A. D. 1932 according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that

the said Nellie McMillon shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of August 1932, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of

(\$3.33) Dollars, (\$8.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the eight Shares of Stock and Five \$33/100 (\$0.33) Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of

Twelve \$27/100 Dollars, (\$8.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Three \$27/100 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of

(\$8.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Three \$20/100 (\$0.20) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of

(\$10.13) Dollars, (\$8.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Two \$13/100 (\$0.13) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of

(\$8.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Three \$07/100 (\$0.07) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of

(\$1.07) Dollars, (\$8.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Three \$07/100 (\$0.07) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.) Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said eight shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by me to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made me, the said Nellie McMillon

and shall pay or cause to be paid all taxes which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against me, the said Nellie McMillon in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that the said Nellie McMillon in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me the said

Nellie McMillon in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

being two lots, First: Lot no. 16 in Section 2 of Lullis Annex, plat of said land being recorded in Plat Book 6, page 101, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, fully described in the deed by The Carolina Loan and Trust Company to me, the said Nellie McMillon, recorded in Deed Book 120, page 176, said R. M. C. Office.

Second: Lot no. 110 on Bailey Street, described on plat recorded in Plat Book A, page 177, and deed to me, said Nellie McMillon, from G. H. Williams, recorded in Deed Book 126, page 84, said R. M. C. Office.

This mortgage takes up and includes the amounts owing to The Carolina Loan and Trust Company by me in mortgages recorded in Volumes 208, page 212, and 187, page 190, on said lots, and for additional money toward building a house on lot no. 10.

All of said plats and deeds are recorded in The R. M. C. Office for said Greenville County.
