I, Hattie R. Fladger
of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, I, Hattie R. Fladger, the said
in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing date the 17th day of June, 1933

incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Twenty five Hundred (\$2500.00) Dollars,
with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly from the 17th day of June, A. D. 1933

according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that I,
the said Hattie R. Fladger, shall pay or cause to be paid to the said

Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of July
1933, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of Forty-one & 6/100

(\$41.67) Dollars, (25.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the
twenty-five Shares of Stock and System (\$16.67) Dollars,

being the monthly interest on the advance or loan until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of
Thirty-eight & 3/100 Dollars, (\$38.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and System (\$38.00) Dollars,

being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of
(\$25.00) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment of said stock and System (\$25.00) Dollars,
being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Thirty-one & 6/100 Dollars, (\$31.67)

Dollars, (25.00 Dollars, being the monthly installment on said shares of stock and
Six & 6/100 Dollars, (\$6.67) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of
Twenty-eight & 3/100 Dollars, (\$28.33) Dollars, (25.00) Dollars, being the

monthly payment on said shares of stock and Three & 3/100 Dollars, (\$3.33) Dollars,
being the monthly interest on balance due.) Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company
the said twenty-five shares of stock and the certificate thereon, the amount at such time paid shares by me to be
credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made me, the said Hattie R. Fladger

and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against me, the said Hattie R. Fladger

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, Hattie R. Fladger, the said Hattie R. Fladger # 12513
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to
the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me the said Hattie R. Fladger

in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged),
have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel
of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

in the City of Greenville, being two lots

1. That lot on Ware Street having a frontage on
said street of 57 1/2 feet with a depth of 209 feet, approp-
riate lots now or formerly owned by J. C. Payne, J. C. Lykes,
and others, being the same lot conveyed to the said
Hattie R. Fladger by Mary M. Calhoun by deed dated
June 16, 1933.

2. That lot on said Ware Street, beginning at an
iron pin on the east side of Ware Street, corner of
lot formerly owned by J. O. Lawton and thence run-
ning in a northerly direction 54.45 feet to an iron
pin; thence in an easterly direction in a line ap-
proximately parallel with Rhett Street 100 feet to an
iron pin; thence in a southerly direction in a line
parallel with Ware Street 54.45 feet to Lawton lot; then
with the J. O. Lawton line in a westerly direction 100
feet to the beginning corner. This is the same lot
