at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell
and release unto the said J. A. Mahaffey, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that Piece, Parcel or lot of land in Greenville County,
State of South Carolina, in City of Greenville and known as
the Ford lot, Beginning at corner of T. W. Davis lot on Jones
Street in the City of Greenville, and running thence with
Jones Street, Sixty Four (64) feet to corner next to remainder
of W. B. and M. M. Ford lot; thence with dividing line,
one hundred (100) feet to corner; thence at right angles, sixty
four (64) feet to corner; thence along line of Davis lot, one
hundred and three (103) feet to the beginning corner, being
the same lot of land conveyed to me by J. A. Watson, by
his deed dated Mar. 31, 1913 and recorded in Vol. 18 at Page
64, R. M. C. office for Greenville County.

Also, all that other lot and parcel of land situate in
