with interest thereon, from Date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be
 computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full interest not paid when due or interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of
 principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount so exceeded shall not fail to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
 sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fees.

One per cent. and one-half, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

 thence with Capers Street N. 5-41 W. 70 feet to the beginning
