with interest thereon from date

at the rate of Six (6%)

per cent. per annum,

to be computed and paid Quarterly annually on the 9th day of October, January, April in each year until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder thereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity, it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of its interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said

cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including ten percent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements situate thereon, in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, more particularly known and designated as Lot No. 3 of Block A of the Buist Property, known as Oakland Heights, and having, according to plat thereof, which is recorded in the R. M. C. of S. C. for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book E, at page 185, the following metes and bounds, to wit: - Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Mountain View Avenue, which iron pin is at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 2 and 3, and running thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 30 W. 189.6 feet; thence S. 65-30 E. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 30 E. 189.6 feet to an iron pin on Mountain View Avenue; thence with the south side of said avenue, N. 65-30 W. 100 feet to the beginning corner.

This description covers all my interest in and to a portion of what formerly constituted a 19 foot alley at the rear of said lot, and is the identical property conveyed to me by deed dated March 12, 1934, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Deeds Volume 175, at Page 301.
