C.

payable as follows:

The sum of \$150.00 to be paid on principal on the 1st day of April, 1937, and a like amount on the first days of July, October, January and April in each year thereafter until the principal has been paid in full, (Repayment Privilege)

(Privilege is given to the Borrower to pay the whole or any part of the principal upon any interest payment date after one year from the date hereof).

With interest thereon from July 1, 1937 at the rate of six (6%) per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid quarterly on the 1st day of April, July, October and January in each year in each year until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate compounded and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder thereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity, it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of its interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including ten percent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.
