O.  $\exists x$ ; thence  $S. 80^{\circ} W. 9.70$  to a B O.  $\exists x$ ; thence  $N. 85^{\circ} W. 1.50$  to a stake  $\exists x$  on a branch; thence down said branch  $S. 20 \frac{2}{3} W. 18.40$  to a stake in a ditch; thence  $S. 67 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E. 1.25$  to a W. O.  $\exists x$ ; thence  $S. 47 \frac{1}{4}^{\circ} W. 2.80$  to a W. O.  $\exists x$ ; thence  $S. 21 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W. 6.20$  to a hickory  $\exists x$ ; thence  $N. 73^{\circ} W. 1.20$  to a willow  $\exists x$  at creek; thence down the creek and old creek line to a persimmon tree  $\exists x$ ; thence  $S. 41^{\circ} W. 4.50$  to a rock; thence  $S. 61^{\circ} W. 2.45$  to a rock; thence  $S. 7 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E. 8.96$  to a rock; thence  $N. 76^{\circ} E. 4.74$  to a rock; thence  $S. W. 50$  links to old creek line; thence down old creek line to a willow near a ditch; thence  $N. 59 \frac{3}{4}^{\circ} E. 6.2$  chains to the beginning corner, containing  $202$  acres, more or less.
