all that tract or lot of land in *R. Mal.* Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

about one and one half miles South of Locust Hill Baptist Church, the East side of road leading from the home of J. M. Langley to Locust Hill Baptist Church; Beginning at a stone on East side of said road and running thence N. 80 E. 5.20 to a stone in a row of Burdock trees; thence due N. with said row of Burdock trees to a stone on the line of Arthur W. Dill land distance 14.50; thence S. 88 W. 6.50 to a stone on edge of gully; thence S. 80 W. 5.40 to a stone on edge of road leading from J. M.
