K. Woods* line, thence *N 54 1/2 W. 124 ft.* to an iron post on *lg. P. Armstrong* line; thence *N. 37 E 132 feet* to *Weston Street*; thence along *Weston Street S. 37 E. 135 feet* to Mrs. *S. K.
