in the full and just sum of Fourteen Hundred (\$1400.00)

Dollars, to be paid sixty days after date with privilege of anticipating payment at any time.

with interest thereon, from date, well and truly paid at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum to be

computed and paid annually, until paid in full all interest accrued when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal and if any portion of

principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); and in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

gain, sell and release unto the said R. B. R. Land Development Company,

its successors and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying and being situate just outside the City of Greenville in a subdivision known as Alta Vista and designated upon a plat of said subdivision as lot no. 69 and a portion of lot no. 75, reference being made to the said plat for a more definite and particular description, the said plat being recorded in office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Plat Book "G" at page 20; and the said lot on that plat being specifically described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the east side of Oliver street at the corner of lot no. 68 on said plat and running thence N. 4-15-6. 254.5 feet to the eastern line of lot no. 75 on said plat; thence along east side of lot no. 75, N. 85-45-W. 65 feet to a corner; thence S. 4-15-W. 254.5 feet to Oliver street; thence along Oliver street, S. 85-40-E. 65 feet to the beginning corner; said conveyance covering all of lot no. 69 and a strip the entire width of lot no. 75 located directly in the rear of lot no. 69; being a portion of the property conveyed to J. W. Norwood by the South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, as trustee.
