Beginning on a stone 3x with R. Dawkins "Page Place", thence N. 9 E. 26. 90 chains to stone 2x, formerly Mr. O. on East bank of Cedar Shoals Creek, thence N. 2 1/2 W. 2. 15 chains to stone 2x with G. A. Norwood, thence N. 51 W. 16. 60 chains to stone 3x, thence S. 3 W. 36. 34 chains to stone 2x, thence S. 75 3/4 E. 11 chains to the beginning, bounded by lands now or formerly of P. Dawkins, G. A. Norwood and G. H. Acker.
